

Shot blasting is an effective mechanical process used to clean and prepare subfloors by removing coatings, laitance, and surface contaminants from concrete and metal surfaces. This method creates a textured profile that improves adhesion for new flooring systems, coatings, or repairs, while keeping dust to a minimum with integrated vacuum recovery.




EPOXY MORTAR REPAIRS

This careful approach prevents damage, making it essential for maintenance, renovations, or preparing floors for new installations.




CONCRETE REPAIRS DELAMINATION
